The following information is provided to ensure you are aware of basic requirements for the safe operation of all recreational vehicles. Each of the following points will be addressed by your rental person to verify that you understand the information and operation.

- 1) **NEVER** occupy trailer while vehicle is in motion.
- 2) **TIE DOWN** all ATV's properly, and secure any other items in the cargo area before travel.
- 3) **SHUT OFF** LP valves, furnace, water heater, refrigerator, stove and generator as well as any other open flame object while refueling gasoline, diesel or propane.
- 4) **REMOVE** Load Equalization hitch *prior* to backing or negotiating sloped terrain.
- 5) **SECURE** any loose object prior to movement of trailer.
- 6) **ALWAYS** use a lookout when backing trailer.
- 7) **BE AWARE** of the total height of your vehicle, including roof mounted accessories, and verify clearance of any low object before attempting to pass beneath.
- 8) **LOCK or SECURE ALL** door locks when trailer is in motion.
- 9) **EXHAUST** ports for furnace and water heater are extremely hot when in use. Contact with these ports will cause burn injury.
- 10) **EMERGENCY** window exits are not to be opened except for emergency. Danger of falling from vehicle exists with emergency exit open. Observe and warn all children of danger.
- 11) **SHOWERS** and tubs are slippery when wet. Do not leave children unattended.
- 12) **ROOFTOPS** are dangerous at *all* times and should not be accessed for any reason.
- 13) **NEVER** attempt to change trailer tires. **ALWAYS** contact a professional tire facility qualified for this operation.
- 14) **RV STEPS, AWNINGS** and other objects are potential hazards during darkness. Be aware of their location and use minimal lighting, if available.
- 15) **DISCONTINUE** travel during high wind conditions.
- 16) **PARKING IN SAND OR MUD** may cause your vehicle to become stuck. Use caution when selecting campsite. Renter is liable for any damages associated with trailer becoming stuck.
